

Installation Guide



Pioneer MP Trigger is distributed as VST3 and AU.

macOS

Pioneer MP Trigger 0.9.0 uses a temporary macOS installation flow while Apple notarization is being completed. The plug-in is fully functional; the extra steps only affect how macOS opens the beta installer.

Before you start, close all DAWs before installing Pioneer MP Trigger or replacing an older beta build.

1. Download the DMG file from the official download link.
2. Open your Downloads folder.
3. Double-click the downloaded **.dmg** file to mount it.
4. In the disk image window, double-click **Pioneer MP Trigger Installer.pkg**.
5. Keep **README.pdf** nearby if you want to use the offline installation guide.

Important: the current beta package is not notarized yet. We are preparing the proper Apple-notarized installer. Because of this, macOS Gatekeeper may block the installer with a warning saying that Apple could not verify the installer is free of malware. Only

continue if you downloaded Pioneer MP Trigger from the official ISINDI DSP website or another trusted official source.

If macOS blocks the package:

1. Click Done in the macOS warning dialog.
2. Open the Apple menu in the top-left corner of the screen.
3. Choose System Settings.
4. Go to Privacy & Security.
5. Scroll down to the Security section.
6. Find the message saying that **Pioneer MP Trigger Installer.pkg** was blocked to protect your Mac.
7. Click Open Anyway.
8. Confirm by clicking Open Anyway again if macOS asks for final confirmation.
9. Continue through the standard macOS Installer.

Installed locations

The package installs both plug-in formats into standard macOS system folders used by DAWs:

/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/Pioneer MP Trigger.vst3

/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/Pioneer MP Trigger.component

After installation

Restart your DAW. If your DAW has a plug-in manager or scanner, rescan plug-ins. Pioneer MP Trigger should appear as both VST3 and Audio Unit.

This temporary security flow does not reduce the quality or functionality of Pioneer MP Trigger. It is only part of the beta installation process while notarization is being completed.

If your DAW still shows a warning:

1. Close the DAW.
2. Open System Settings > Privacy & Security.
3. Allow Pioneer MP Trigger if macOS shows a blocked plug-in message.
4. Open the DAW again.
5. Rescan plug-ins.

Windows

Before you start, close all DAWs before installing Pioneer MP Trigger or replacing an older build.

1. Download the Windows Pioneer MP Trigger package from the official download link.
2. Open your Downloads folder.
3. If the file is a **.zip** archive, right-click it and choose Extract All, then open the extracted folder.
4. If the package contains an installer, double-click the installer and follow the installation steps.
5. If the package contains a **.vst3** file for manual installation, copy it to the standard Windows VST3 folder:

C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3

6. Restart your DAW.
7. If your DAW has a plug-in manager or scanner, rescan plug-ins.
8. Pioneer MP Trigger should appear in your DAW as a VST3 plug-in.

Important: the current Windows build may not be Microsoft Authenticode code-signed and may not use a trusted Windows publisher certificate. Because of this, Microsoft Defender SmartScreen may show a warning that the app or installer is from an unknown publisher, or that Windows protected your PC. Only continue if you downloaded Pioneer MP Trigger from the official ISINDI DSP website or another trusted official source.

If Windows SmartScreen blocks the installer:

1. In the SmartScreen warning window, click More info.
2. Check that the app or installer name is related to **Pioneer MP Trigger**.
3. Click Run anyway.
4. Continue through the installer.

If Windows security settings block the downloaded file before launch:

1. Right-click the downloaded installer, archive, or extracted file.
2. Choose Properties.
3. Open the General tab.
4. If you see a Security message saying the file came from another computer and might be blocked, enable Unblock.
5. Click Apply.
6. Click OK.
7. Run the installer again or copy the plug-in file again.

After installation

Restart your DAW. If your DAW has a plug-in manager or scanner, rescan plug-ins.

If Pioneer MP Trigger does not appear in your DAW:

1. Make sure the plug-in was installed or copied to the standard VST3 folder:

`C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3\`

2. Open your DAW plug-in manager.
3. Rescan VST3 plug-ins.
4. Restart the DAW.
5. Check whether Pioneer MP Trigger appears in the plug-in list.
